

1. Child Marriage Scenario in Bangladesh: Challenges & Way Forward

Objectives:

- Conduct a quantitative and qualitative assessment of the status of Child Marriage in Bangladesh;
- Analyze how Child Marriage takes place & find out the reasons behind it;
- Review the proposed *Child Marriage Restraint Rules* and analyze existing *Child Marriage Restraint Act* in support for putting an end to Child Marriage & indicate the weakness of the Act;
- Recommend an implementation roadmap for stopping Child Marriage in Bangladesh.

Conditions:

1. A detailed study proposal based on the above mentioned objectives;
2. The proposal must contain a methodology & definite timeframe with milestones;
3. List of final deliverables;
4. Each study should contain at least 30 pages comprehensively, Font 12, and 1.5 space (Except bibliography & Annexure);
5. The study report should be in English Language;
6. Study report should be submitted within 45 working days from the date of getting work order;
7. Each person/ Institutions if wants to apply for more than one proposals then, they have to submit their study proposal in separate envelope addressed to the Secretary, NHRCB and drawing attention of Director (Admin & Finance) of NHRCB;
8. VAT, Tax will be deducted according to the Rules;
9. The budget for each study will be BDT 400,000 (Four Lac) only ;
10. Authority reserves the right to alter, modify and repeal any Technical Proposal and Terms of Reference;
11. Each Institutions/ Persons willing to submit the Technical Proposal, must submit their Curriculum Vitae & experience on Research Works.



12. Each Institutions/ Persons must submit 3 (Three Copies) of their Proposals in both hard copies and soft copies in CD format.
13. Deadline of submission of Technical Proposals will be on 28/06/17 before 12:00pm and Technical Proposals will be opened on 28/06/17 at 12:30pm.
