JAMAKON aids to withdraw money from GPF

Fariha (pseudo name) from Khulna lived with her husband in in-laws home. After BDR mutiny in 2009, her husband was jailed in the BDR mutiny case for four years. In the four years, she had to live a miserable life due to poverty. She had to manage food for her father in law and mother in law.

Finding no solution of her poverty, she tried to withdraw money from her husband's General Provident Fund. She went to related offices including Ministry of Home Affairs. But she could not get it. Seeing no hope, she lodged a complaint in National Human Rights Commission (JAMAKON), Bangladesh.

JAMAKON took the case seriously and issued notices to Senior Secretary of Ministry of Home Affairs to take immediate steps in this regard. In the meantime her husband released from prison. With support from JAMAKON, her husband got money from his GPF.
